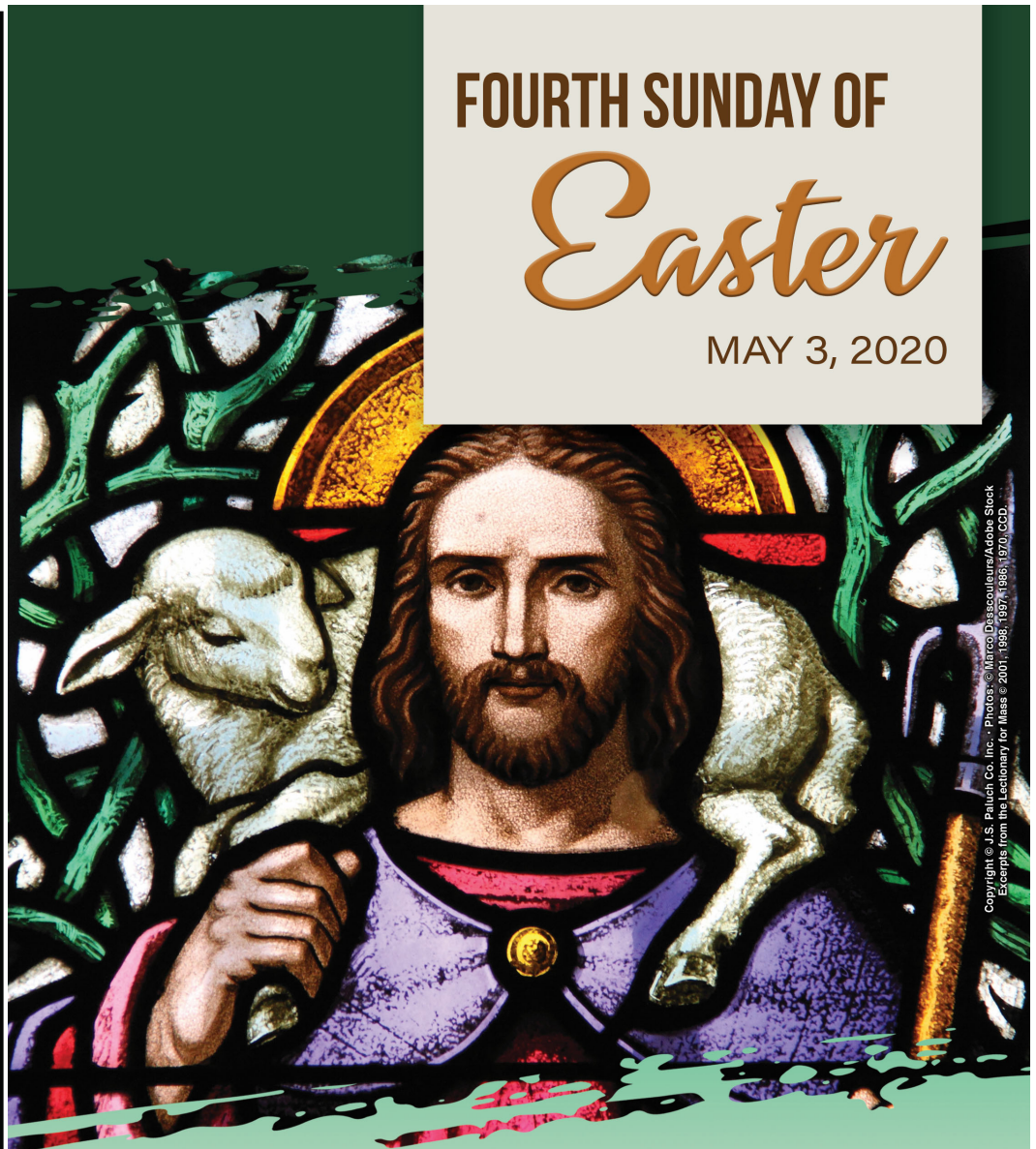

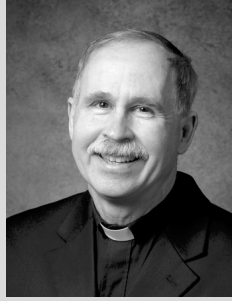

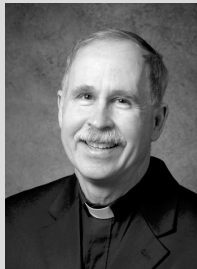
Stewardship Reflection May 3, 2020
