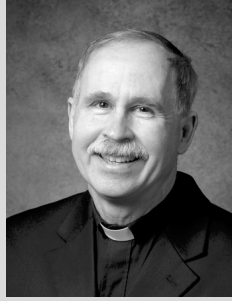

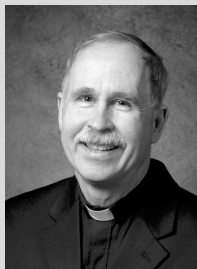
Stewardship Reflection May 10, 2020
