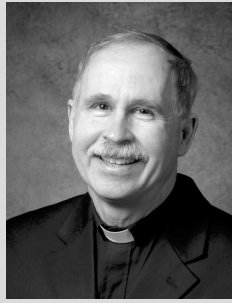

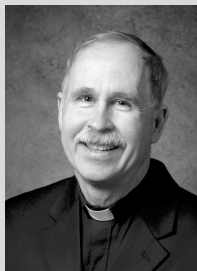
Stewardship Reflection May 24, 2020
