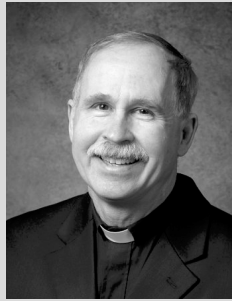

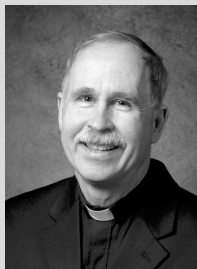
Stewardship Reflection June 7, 2020
