**St. Mary’s Food Kitchen**

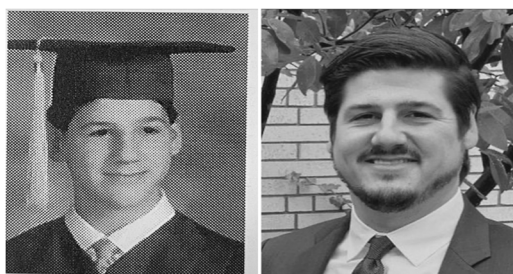
