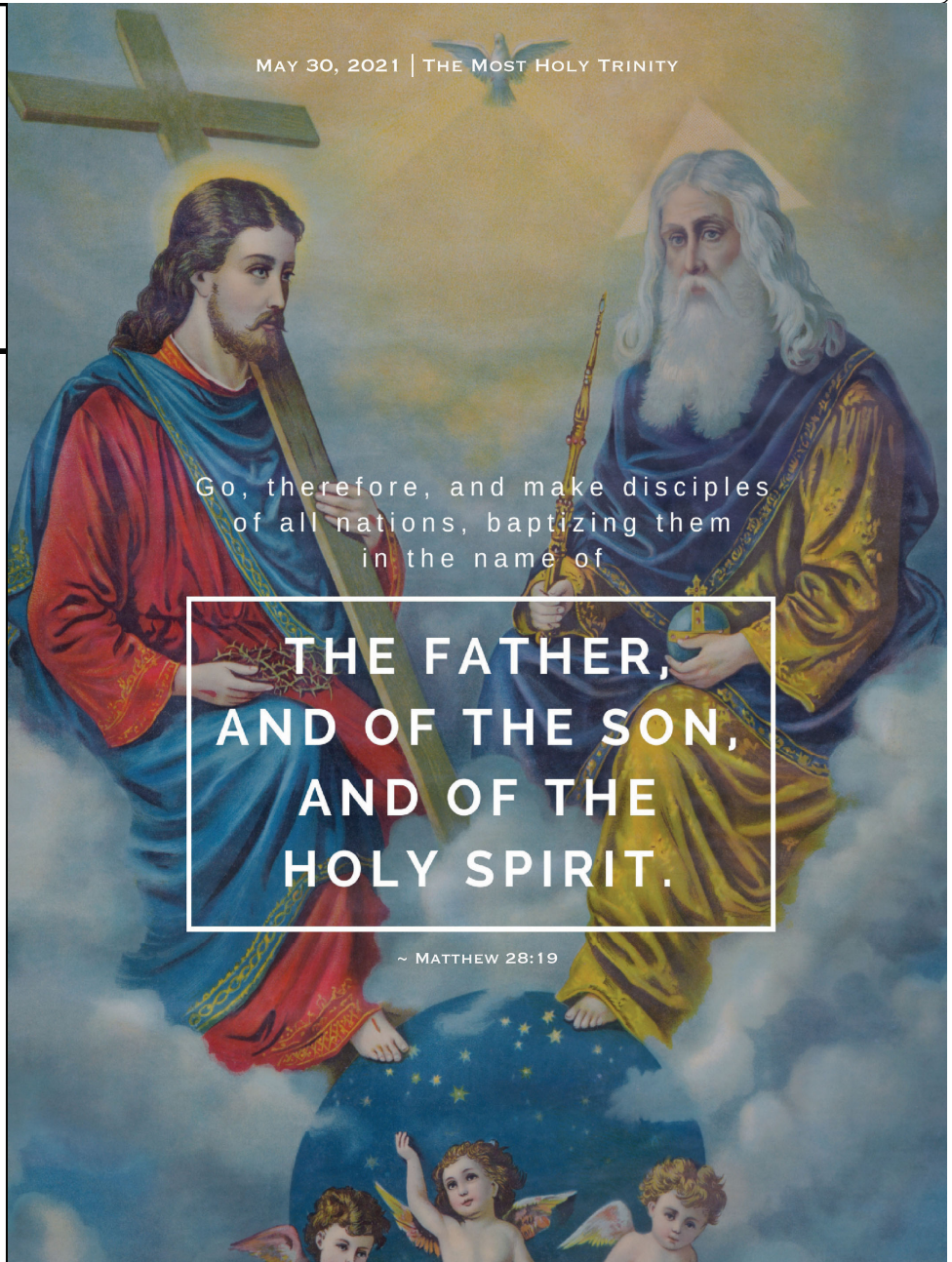

El Misterio de la Santísima Trinidad

Un sólo Dios en tres Personas distintas, es el misterio central de la fe y de la vida cristiana, pues es el misterio de Dios en Sí mismo.

Aunque es un dogma difícil de entender, fue el primero que entendieron los Apóstoles. Después de la Resurrección, comprendieron que Jesús era el Salvador enviado por el Padre. Y, cuando experimentaron la acción del Espíritu Santo dentro de sus corazones en Pentecostés, comprendieron que el único Dios era Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.

Los católicos creemos que la Trinidad es Una. No creemos en tres dioses, sino en un sólo Dios en tres Personas distintas. No es que Dios esté dividido en tres, pues cada una de las tres Personas es enteramente Dios.

Fiesta de la Visitación de la Virgen María

Cada 31 de mayo, la Iglesia celebra la Fiesta de la Visitación de la Virgen María a su prima Santa Isabel, y con este mensaje de caridad de la Madre de Dios es que se concluye el mes mariano.

Según narran los evangelios, el ángel Gabriel le dijo a María que así como ella iba a ser la Madre de Jesús, su prima Isabel también estaba encinta de Juan el Bautista y la Virgen fue en ayuda de su pariente durante tres meses.

De este relato evangélico surgen dos importantes oraciones: la segunda parte del Avemaría y el canto del Magnificat.

Cuando Isabel oyó el saludo de María, “el niño saltó en su seno. Entonces Isabel, llena del Espíritu Santo, exclamó a grandes voces: ‘¡Bendita tú entre las mujeres y bendito el fruto de tu vientre! Pero ¿cómo es posible que la madre de mi Señor venga a visitarme? Porque en cuanto oí tu saludo, el niño saltó de alegría en mi seno’”. Celebra esta Fiesta de la Iglesia asistiendo a misa, rezando el Santo Rosario, o recitando el Magnificat.

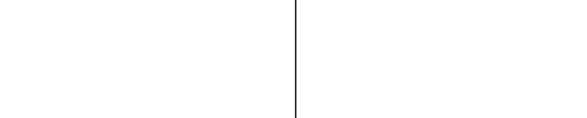
