What is Celebration?

Have you ever wondered how Celebration began at Holy Cross?

The first Celebration was held in the church basement as a Las Vegas Night with casino games, drinks and basic snacks. Rhonda Kelley was the original chair for the event.

The following year, Celebration was moved from the Church basement to the school. A buffet dinner was served before a live auction. Over the years, some great chefs from our Holy Cross community prepared elaborate meals and oversaw the dining area. Several years later, Celebration grew its auction offerings by adding in a silent auction and using classrooms as themed rooms for items. The live auction was called by the Nigro Brothers auctioneers. Examples of items that our community brought to the table for auction were a Jamal Charles Jersey, Big Cedar Lodge weekend, dinner for 20 at Rudy's Tenampa Taqueria, a week in Breckenridge, as well as the student favorite, "Principal for a day." We have been supported by so many donors over the years, both big and small. Each and every one has made a difference in the growth of our Holy Cross community.



This past year, a lot changed at Holy Cross, including Celebration. While COVID-19 got in the way of our original in-person plan, *Celebration-Be the Light* was held virtually. Even though we could not physically be together, our community rallied to make it a wonderful event. We gathered as small groups in homes to watch the livestream hosted by a group of parishioners at Landers Vision. It was also special that the school children got to enjoy Celebration this year, live from their living rooms!

An exciting new feature of the event included awarding the new Beacon of Light Award. This award celebrates an individual's outstanding contributions toward enhancing the rich Holy Cross tradition and continuing to build our legacy. They give their time, talent and/or treasure, so more students and families can benefit from the unique culture and experience of the Holy Cross Community. Our 2021 recipients were Fr. Tony Lickteig, Fr. Bob Pflumm, Fr. Mark Mertes, Fr. Mike Stubbs, and Rudy and Margi Garcia.
