The first graders are very excited to be working with the Kindergarten class as we plan our first Mass together. We are working hard to finish up the year Holy Cross strong!

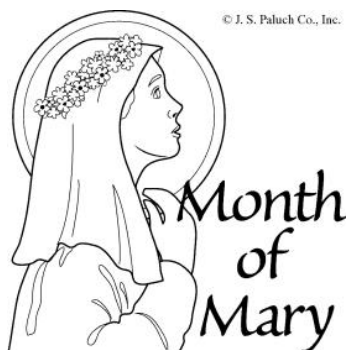
