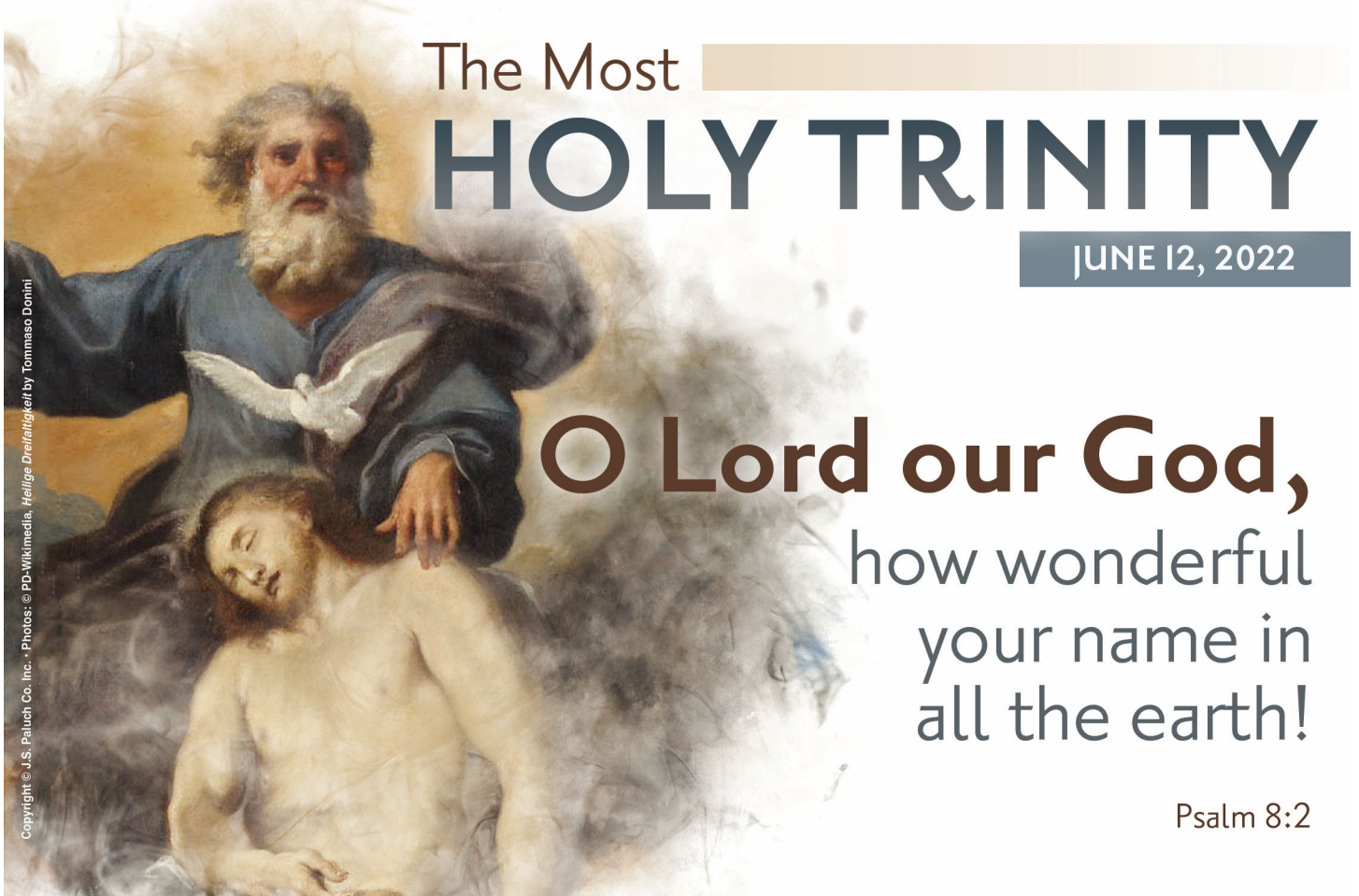

St. Marys

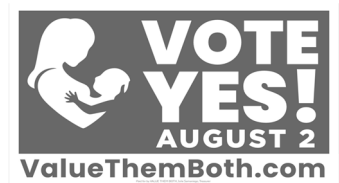

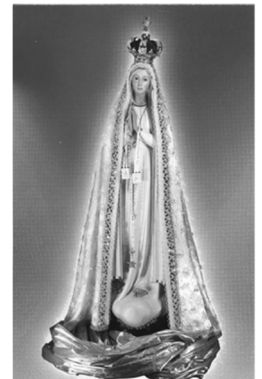
