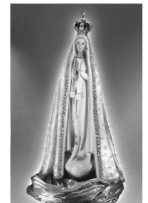

## Value Them Both Message from Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have just celebrated the annual anniversary of the birth of our nation. We are fortunate to live in the United States of America and to enjoy the many freedoms and opportunities that our founders and many other Americans for the past 250 years have made heroic sacrifices to protect and preserve. We have a sacred responsibility to be engaged and active citizens, in particular, exercising our right to vote.

The most important election of our generation is almost here. I am not asking or encouraging you to vote for a candidate or a person, but for the protection of women and preborn babies from the Kansas abortion industry. I ask you to vote YES for the Value Them Both Amendment.

It is probable that there are some in Church today, who have been harmed by abortion. I am grateful that you are with us in Church. If you are suffering because of your involvement with an abortion, I invite you to reach out to Project Rachel or Project Joseph ministries that are designed to bring healing and mercy to those wounded by abortion. Our Lord wants to heal you from the guilt and comfort you from the grief that inevitably result from abortion.

Contrary to what you have been hearing from paid advertisements by the abortion industry or misinformation in the secular press, Value Them Both is a reasonable, common sense response to the extreme ruling by the Kansas Supreme Court that has cleared the path for unregulated and unrestricted abortions in our State.

Regardless of the recent U.S. Supreme Court's ruling, Kansas will remain a destination State for unlimited abortion, unless we pass the Value Them Both Amendment. Already abortion rates in Kansas are soaring, after more than two decades of steady decline. Half of the abortions performed in Kansas are on women from surrounding states.

In the estimation of the Kansas Supreme Court, virtually any previous law or regulation of abortion is now "presumed unconstitutional." Value You Them Both will allow the people of Kansas, not a few unelected judges, to decide:

- Whether taxpayers should be coerced to fund abortion,
- Whether parents have a right to know about their minor daughter's pregnancy,
- Whether women have a right to know the possible physical and psychological consequences of abortion,
- Whether mother's have a right to see ultrasound images of their child,
- Whether abortion facilities are required to observe health and safety standards.

Already, two Kansas laws have been struck down because of the Court's erroneous ruling – 1) a basic health clinic inspection and sanitation law and 2) a ban on live dismemberment abortions. A YES vote for Value Them Both will allow these common-sense laws to once again be enforceable. A YES vote returns to the people of Kansas, through their elected representatives, the ability to enact laws that protect women and children from the abortion industry.

This is a defining moment in Kansas. We have the opportunity to decide, if we want Kansas to become a destination State for unlimited abortion in unregulated facilities or if we want to put the health and safety of preborn children and women ahead of the interests of the abortion industry.

The Church and the Pro-Life community seek to surround every woman experiencing an untimely pregnancy with a community of support and love. The staff and volunteers of Pregnancy Resource Centers accompany mothers throughout their pregnancy for as long as needed so that both mother and child not only survive, but thrive.

I have requested every Parish in the Archdiocese to participate in the Walking with Moms in Need Program that connects pregnant women with important resources and strives to surround them with a network of loving support. I encourage every member of the Archdiocese to support Pregnancy Resource Centers in your local community.

The Lord wants to empower each of us to help build a Culture of Life and a Civilization of Love, where abortion will become unthinkable. A critical first step to do this in Kansas is to vote YES for the Value Them Both Amendment. Early voting begins July 14 and election day is August 2. Together, we can protect Kansas from being a destination for death and make it a destination for life, where every mother is loved and every child is cherished.

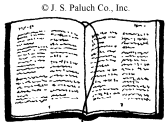
