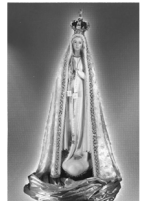

Catechism Corner

Who can receive the sacrament of the anointing of the sick? Any member of the faithful can receive this sacrament as soon as he or she begins to be in danger of death because of sickness or old age. The faithful who receive this sacrament can receive it several times if their illness becomes worse or another serious sickness afflicts them. The celebration of this sacrament should, if possible, be preceded by individual confession on the part of the sick person.

VALUE THEM BOTH

What you need to know.

VALUE THEM BOTH is the proposed state constitutional amendment up for a vote by Kansans on August 2nd. The amendment is a reasonable response to an extreme ruling by the Kansas Supreme Court in 2019 that declared abortion to be a virtually unlimited and unrestricted right. - 16% increase** in abortions performed on out-of-state residents

- ✓ Restore our state Constitution to the way it was before the extreme court ruling cleared the path for virtually unlimited abortion in Kansas.
- ✓ Protect commonsense restrictions on the abortion industry and prevent taxpayer-funded abortion.
