MULTIPURPOSE CENTER IN GHANA

This weekend March 18/19, Fr. Beyuo Kuukole, a priest from the Diocese of Damongo, Ghana, West Africa working in our archdiocese, will speak at Mass. He invites us to be part of an important project in Ghana, building a Multipurpose Center for Youth Formation and Human Development. You can donate through Holy Cross to support this very important project.

The Multipurpose Center we hope to build is situated in Tom, Ghana, and will be used for church services, education programs for children, youth formation, catechesis and religious education, evangelization, human development and other community programs.

The Diocese of Fr. Beyuo, (Damongo Diocese) is an impoverished rural area with an extremely high illiteracy rate (80% among women and 73% among men) due to the lack of schools and poverty. The area lacks drinkable water, health care facilities, schools and places of worship (chapels) in the rural communities. About 80% of the inhabitants of the diocese are animists (worshippers of African Traditional Religion), but are open to Christianity.

The pastoral priorities of the church include: education and human promotion of the youth, provision of good drinking water (drilling of boreholes), building of health care facilities in our deprived communities, faith formation of the laity, youth and families; training of seminarians for the priesthood and formation of catechists for the work of primary evangelization; upkeep and support of the pastoral work of the priests; building of churches for worship in the mission stations. About 70% of the Catholic population in this diocese are youth. The parishioners from one rural community (mostly women and children) walk over 4 miles to attend Mass.
