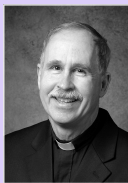

FROM FR. MIKE:

Dear Parishioners,



As we begin Advent, we also begin to use the new translation of the Mass prayers. Some people are dreading this change, while others look upon it as the best thing since sliced bread. In my opinion, I believe that the transition will happen much more easily than many think. For the congregation, it will not be that big of a change. The most important thing for the congregation to remember, is to say "And with your spirit," when the priest says, "The Lord be with you." This is a dialogue which occurs several times during the Mass. It will take a little time to become habitual. In addition, the Nicene creed translation has some noticeable changes. Otherwise, it should be a piece of cake for the congregation, since the invariable parts which are sung have already been changed. On the other hand, the new translation will pose more of a challenge for the priests, since we will have to relearn prayers that we have memorized. It also will pose a challenge for our altar servers, who will have to hold a missal which weighs considerably more than the current one.

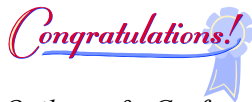
