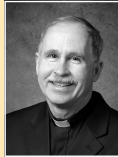

Dear Parishioners,

During the Easter season, Sunday Mass often opens with the blessing and sprinkling of Holy Water, rather than the penitential rite. We do this in order to remind ourselves of the importance and purpose of our baptism. After all, baptism is the sacrament which inserts us into the paschal mystery of Christ's death and resurrection, which we celebrate especially during the Easter season. In addition, the Missal also encourages us to recite the Apostles' creed, rather than the Nicene creed, during the Easter season. Once again, the Apostles' creed is linked to baptism. Originally, the person being baptized was asked three questions. After an affirmative response to each question, the person was then dunked into the water. For example, the first question went: "Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth?" Eventually, those questions were reformulated into statements, and gave us the Apostles' creed.

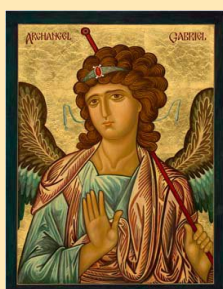


### CINCO DE MAYO FIESTA!

Durante el Tiempo de Pascua, la Misa del domingo empieza con la bendición y salpicadura de Agua Bendita, en vez del Rito Penitencial. Hacemos esto para recordar la importancia y el propósito de nuestro bautizo. Después de todo, el bautizo es el sacramento que nos introduce dentro del misterio pascual de la muerte y resurrección de Cristo, los cuáles celebramos especialmente durante el Tiempo de Pascua. 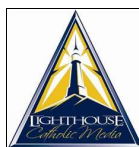
