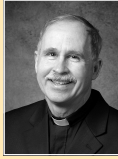

Dear Parishioners,

A committee has formed and has begun to meet, to prepare for the renovation of the church interior. Naturally, one of the first things we are doing is to look at costs. 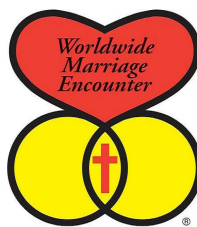
