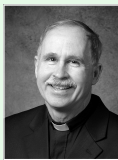

Recently, you received a financial report for the parish as an insert in the bulletin. It covers the period from July 1, 2011 through March 31, 2012. It also shows a deficit of nearly \$56,000 for our annual budget. That will increase by the time we end the fiscal year. From this, I draw the following conclusion. Either we increase revenue, or we will be forced to cut back on some of the services and programs offered at the parish. I realize that many families are going through rough times financially. That is also true of institutions, such as our parish. If you are able to increase your contributions to the parish even by a little, it would greatly help in solving this dilemma. Thank you.

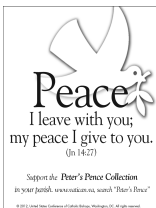

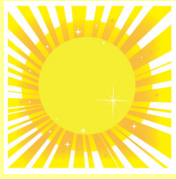

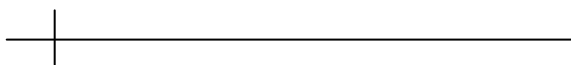
## Service Opportunities
