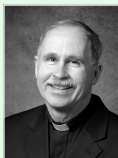

I prefer not to take that Mass, since I already have the 5:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday and always have the possibility of another Mass because of a wedding or funeral. At the same time, Fr. Anthony will probably not be available to celebrate every Saturday morning Mass. Because of that, we are considering retaining only the First Saturday morning Mass, and eliminating the other Saturday morning Masses. This appears to be the best solution.

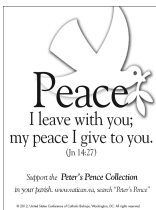

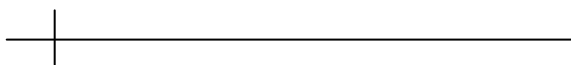
Service Opportunities

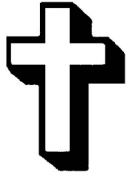

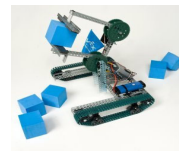
