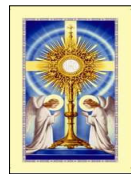

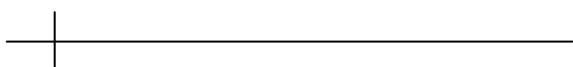
Confirmation

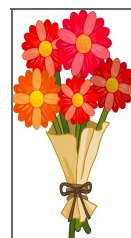

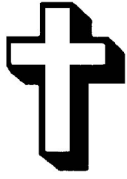

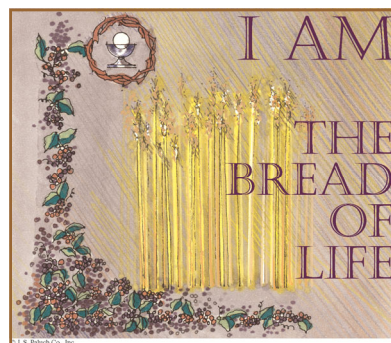
