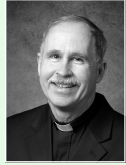

Dear Parishioners,

As the elections approach, materials endorsing various political candidates are starting to appear more frequently. In the midst of this, we should remember that the policy of the Catholic Church forbids church organizations to engage in this activity. Specifically, "Catholic organizations may not make statements, either oral or written, supporting or opposing any candidate for elective public office, any slate of candidates, political party or political action committee. ... A Catholic organization should not distribute or authorize distribution of campaign literature, biased voter education material, etc. ... Thus, a Catholic organization should not authorize the distribution of biased or partisan campaign materials in the parking lot." (Office of General Counsel, National Conference of Catholic Bishops/United States Catholic Conference) We ask your cooperation in this matter. We also ask that businesses not place flyers on the windshields of cars in our parking lot. If businesses wish to advertize, they can place an ad in the bulletin.

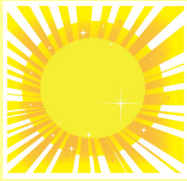

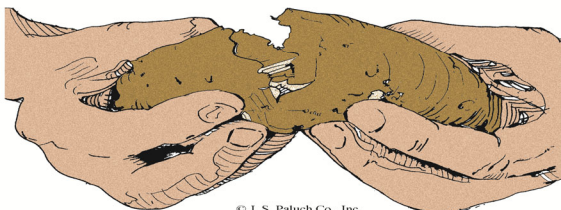
## Confirmation

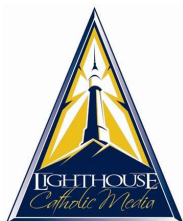
