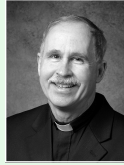

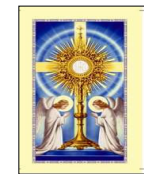

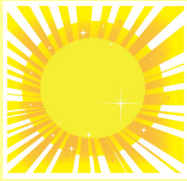
Town Hall Meeting

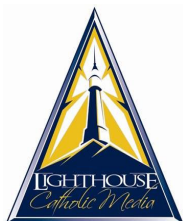
