Therefore, the photos of those whose names begin with "a,b,c,d,e,f" will go on display from Nov. 1 to Nov. 9, those whose names begin with "g,h,i,j,k,l" will go on display Nov. 10 to Nov. 16, those whose names begin with "m,n,o,p,q,r" will go on display Nov. 17 to Nov. 23, those whose names begin with "s,t,u,v,w,x,y,z" will go on display Nov. 24 to Nov. 30.

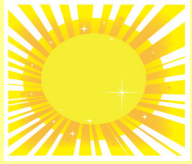
