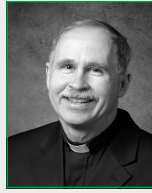

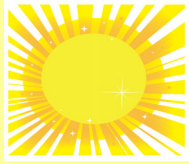

*“Whom shall I send? ... Here I am, send me!” Isaiah 6:8*

Isaiah is so enthusiastic when he answers God's call in today's first reading. Just as he asked Isaiah, God asks us, “Whom shall I send?” Sometimes the call is something small—an attempt to cheer a friend who is down or a quick errand for a sick relative. Other times the call is something more—taking on a new ministry or pet-sitting for a neighbor who will be gone for two weeks. How eagerly do we respond to God's call? Do we answer in a way that is pleasing to God?

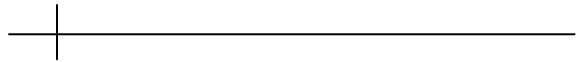
