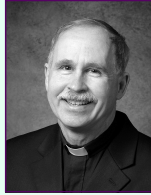
Dear Parishioners,

We also wish to avoid the possibility of injury to persons. The statue is extremely heavy. If it were to fall on someone, it could kill that person. There have been cases where a person playing around a tombstone in a cemetery caused it to fall over, killing that person. Please, please, please, parents supervise your children. God has entrusted them to you. They are your responsibility.

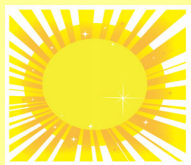
