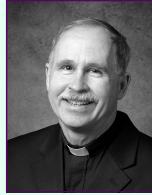

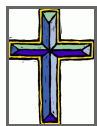

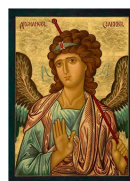
The Time is Now for Immigration Reform
