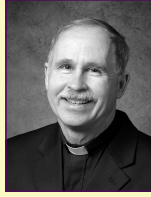

Dear Parishioners,

You may have noticed that some of our children are making their First Holy Communion during the weekend Masses. Instead of holding a separate Mass for First Holy Communion, we have started on this approach this year. There are several reasons for this. Some parishes have followed this model for years, and it has worked well there. It offers some practical advantages. For example, families have some options on what date they choose for the First Communion. But the most important reason is a theological one. The Eucharist is a sacrament of initiation. That means that it makes us belong to the Church. It makes sense for that sacrament to take place in the midst of the community, rather than separated from it. The entire parish cannot be present, but at least a portion of it, when the child makes his or her First Holy Communion. And the whole Church is made present in our parish. "This Church of Christ is really present in all legitimately organized local groups of the faithful, which, in so far as they are united with their pastors, are also quite appropriately called Churches in the New Testament." (*Lumen Gentium* #26)

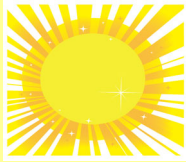

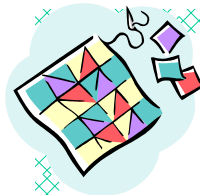


#### Teen Pro-Life Boot Camp 2014

## “Encuentro”

### **Queridos feligreses:**

Habrán notado que alguno de nuestros niños están haciendo su Primera Comunión durante las Misas del fin de semana. En vez de celebrar una misa separada para la Primera Comunión, hemos tomado esta opción este año. Hay algunas razones para esta decisión. Algunas parroquias han seguido este modelo por años y les ha ido bien. Esto les ofrece ventajas prácticas. Por ejemplo, las familias tienen algunas opciones en la fecha que escojen para la Primera Comunión. Pero la razón principal es la teológica.

La Eucaristía es un sacramento de iniciación. Esto quiere decir que nos hace pertenecer a la Iglesia. Es razonable que este sacramento se celebre en frente de la comunidad, en vez de separadamente. La parroquia completa no puede estar presente, pero al menos una porción sí lo estará, cuando los niños hacen su Primera Comunión. Y toda la Iglesia estará presente en nuestra parroquia. “Esta Iglesia de Cristo está presente realmente en todos los grupos de feligreses organizados legítimamente, los cuáles, mientras los pastores estén presente, también son llamadas apropiadamente Iglesias en el Nuevo Testamento.” (*Lumen Gentium* #26)
