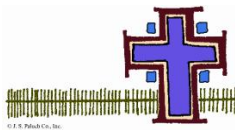

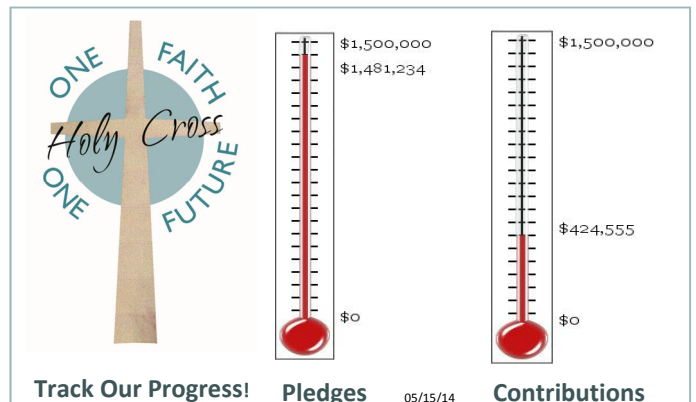

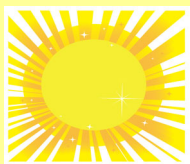
Summer Weekend Retreat June 27-29

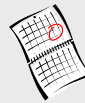

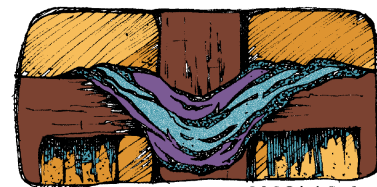
