In a couple of weeks, on Monday Oct. 24, our parish will hold a town hall meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to gather ideas for a Master Plan for the orderly development of our parish grounds and to receive feedback on ideas already submitted. If you have an idea for something that should go in the Master plan, at this point you would not need to present any details, only what the item is, and where it would be located. Two proposals that are being submitted are: 1. The expansion of the Early Education Center, 2. Senior Living Housing on the field south of the parking lot. Keep in mind that we are putting together this Master Plan so that the development of parish property can proceed in an orderly fashion. Inclusion of an item in the Master Plan does not guarantee that it would happen. It only provides a place for it.

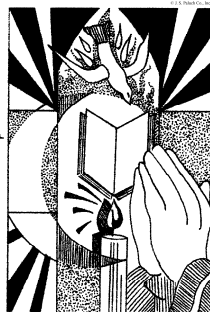

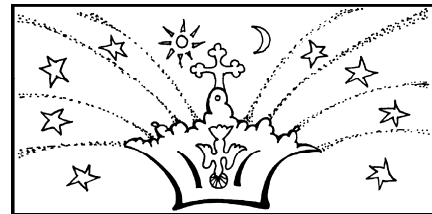

On **Sunday, October 16th**, Pope Francis will be canonizing **Jose Luis Sanchez del Rio**. This new saint was part of the Cristero movement in Mexico in the 1920's. He is a major character in the film "For Greater Glory" which recounts the events of the Cristeros. In 1928 Jose Luis, at 14 years old, gave his life witnessing to Christ, and fighting for the Church and her freedom during the oppressive communist government in Mexico at the time. He is a tremendous saint, who had unshakable faith amidst tremendous persecution. We as a parish are very blessed to have as members several families from his state in Mexico. **The Hispanic Community will be celebrating his canonization on the day of his canonization, Sunday, Oct 16th, with a procession around the church parking lot with an image of the new saint, as well as a first class relic (a relic that is a small piece of one of his bones).** The procession will begin at **1:00pm** in front of the rectory, and will conclude in the church with the usual Spanish Sunday Mass.
